'NOVACARE' is a mopping fluid with a protective residue for use on vinyl, vinyl asbestos, linoleum, thermoplastic, sealed wood, sealed cork, terrazzo and marble floors.

Directions for Use

For best results, remove old emulsion polishes. Sweep, dust-mop or vacuum away loose dirt and litter. Dilute 400ml of 'NOVACARE' per 5 litres of cold water. Later this can be reduced to 200ml per 5 litres. Damp wipe, frequently washing out the mop in the solution. If desired, the floor may be burnished after it has dried.
