

**Job Title:** Part Time Youth Worker Hatch Warren Community Association

**Key Duties**

- Develop positive relationships with young people based on an understanding of the youth workers role.
- As part of a youth work team, create opportunities for young people to explore issues that are important to them and enable them to make more informed choices about their actions and their lives.
- Assist in the planning, implementing and evaluation of programmes that reflect the priorities of Hatch Warren Community Association and which meet the identified needs of young people.
- Ensure that young people have relevant information, advice and support and the opportunity to discuss and explore that information.
- To facilitate and encourage young people's involvement in democracy and decision making within their local community and in society as a whole.
- As part of a youth work team, engage young people in new opportunities and challenging experiences.
- To participate in the process of identifying young people's needs and interests and developing provision which helps those needs to be met.
- To maintain records of events and activities
- Work corporately with other team members in the planning and co-ordination of youth work.
- Ensure all work is undertaken with Hatch Warren Community Association policies, in particular those relating to safe guarding and health and safety
