

The Beers.....

- 1. Beartown – Bearly Literate 4.5%**
A golden pale ale offering crisp hoppy flavours with a smooth malty finish. Dry hopped for a fuller flavour.
- 2. Black Hole Brewery - Red Dwarf 4.5%**
A distinctive dry taste and a ruby red colour form the basis of this bitter. Challenger hops provide a fruity finish and the malt combination give an underlying toffee flavour.
- 3. Corvedale – Dark & Delicious 4.6%**
A dark ruby beer with hops on the aroma and palate and a sweet aftertaste
- 4. Elgoods – Greyhound 5.2%**
A rich brown strong bitter with a full flavour derived from the use of pale ale malt, torrified wheat and roast barley and a hop blend of English Fuggles and Challenger. A rich raisin character is the result of dark sugars and roasted barley.
- 5. Fallen Angel – Cowgirl Gold 4.2%**
A pale golden ale made using Sussex Bramling Cross hops to give the beer a great deal of flavour. It is smooth and bitter with extraordinary flavour and smoothness. Whether you're ridin', ropin', dancin', or romancin', you'll be yelling "Yippee Ky A" after a couple of these thrilling and sensational beers.
- 6. Green Jack – Gone Fishing 5.5%**
A strong, golden pale Ale which is very light-drinking and very moreish.
- 7. H&B – Reiver IPA 4.4%**
A dark golden bitter with a clean citrus palate and aroma, and a subtle malt flavour.
- 8. Hawkshead – Red 4.2%**
A Red Ale. Bitter-sweet. First comes the sweetness of the dark crystal malt, which gives it the red colour, and then the long dry finish. A beer for those who like their ale to have some colour and taste of malt.
- 9. Lees JW – Bitter 4.00%**
A all-malt brew. Amber coloured with a malty and citrus fruit aftertaste. A classic North-West session bitter.
- 10. Otley – O2 Croes O 4.2%**
Light coloured ale bursting with citrus flavours and big nose aromas.
- 11. Otter – Amber 4.00%**
A beautifully polished amber ale with a blend of citrus and spice in the aroma. The special Cara malt and carefully selected hops in Amber deliver a finely balanced bitter flavour, with hints of tropical fruit and spice – sometimes even an impression of ginger.
- 12. Phoenix – Struggling Monkey 4.5%**
Pale coloured, well-balanced beer using American and English hops.
- 13. Purple Moose – Snowdonia 3.6%**
Cwrw Eyri" - A delightfully refreshing pale ale brewed with pale and crystal malts combined with a delicate combination of Pioneer, Styrian Goldings and Lubelski hops.
- 14. Purple Moose – Dark Side of the Moose... 4.6%**
"Ochr Tywyll Y Mws" - A delicious dark ale with a dry biscuit flavour from the roasted barley and a fruity bitterness from the use of Bramling Cross hops.
- 15. Rudgate – Battleaxe 4.2%**
A robust premium bitter with an initial sweetness and gentle bitterness, leading to a complex fruity flavour.
- 16. Saltaire – Blackberry Cascade 4.8%**
An American style pale ale, hopped with Cascade and Centennia hops, infused with a hint of blackberries.
- 17. Skinners – Cornish Knocker 4.5%**
A strong, clean tasting golden ale, not too sweet with a fresh flowery aroma. Cornish Knockers were known as the Tin Mine Fairies. They lived down the mines and used to guide the miners to the rich vein of tin with their knocking. The miners would throw the left over crusts from their Cornish pasties into the mine to keep the right side of the Knockers. Due to the demise of mining the Knockers have come above ground , in disguise, to help with the brewing of their ales.
- 18. Stonehenge – Pigswill 4.0%**
This is a full-bodied, not so bitter beer but rich in hop aroma which gives the beer a delightful aftertaste. The warm amber colour is very appealing to the eye.
- 19. Westerham – British Bulldog 4.3%**
A rich, full bodied best bitter in the traditional Kent style. Finest Maris Otter pale ale malt and Crystal malt for colour and richness. Hopped with local Northdown and Whitbread Golding variety hops for a full flavour and aroma.
- 20. Williams Bros. Heather Fraoch Ale 4.10%**
Brewed with malted barley and heather flower tips to create a multi-award winning beer. A light amber ale with a floral/peaty aroma, full malt character, a spicy herbal flavour and a dry, wine-like finish.

From our Local Breweries

21. **Andwell – Resolute Bitter 3.8%**
Light amber best bitter with balanced aromas & bitterness
22. **Andwell – Gold Muddler 3.9%**
Golden blonde ale with fresh taste and citrus aroma .
23. **Ascot Ales – Alley Cat 3.8%**
Our new light copper ale is packed full of flavour. Refreshing and hoppy with Brewers Gold hops giving gorgeous aromas of tropical and lemony fruits. A terrific session ale.
24. **Ascot Ales – Posh Pooch 4.2%**
Our flagship Bitter pours a rich copper colour with a sweet malt taste and toffee notes.
25. **Ascot Ales – Single Hop Sorachi Ace**
26. **Ascot Ales – On the Rails 3.8%**
A dark ale with a sophisticated blend of malts combined with a distinctive hop character.
27. **Itchen Valley – Godfathers 3.8%**
Excellent quaffing ale full in flavour, light golden with a crisp distinctive bittersweet edge.
28. **Itchen Valley – Fagins 4.1%**
Named after the Dickens character from Oliver Twist. This rogues namesake is a light brown, well balanced bitter brewed with 3 English hops - First Gold, Fuggles and Goldings.
29. **West Berkshire Brewery – Strickle & Horn 4.3%**
Strickle and Horn is a copper coloured beer and strongly hopped, with a fruity finish.
30. **West Berkshire Brewery – Whimble 4.3%.**
31. **Laverstoke – Organic Ale 5.0%**
A consistent bubble with the smell and the ensuing taste of a mildly sweet malt character followed by a nice dry bite, even something like a mild IPA in its hoppiness. Perfectly drinkable on a warm day!

Ciders.....

1. **Westons Old Rosie 7.3%**
Allowed to settle out naturally after fermentation, giving it the traditional cloudy appearance and character of true old fashioned scrumpy. It has a robust character.
- 2 **Biddendens Dry 8.0%**
Made from a blend of dessert and culinary apples
3. **Thatchers 6.0%**
For those who want an alternative refreshing drink with a touch of natural sparkle. Naturally fermented, matured in oak vats to ensure the distinctive full flavour is retained.
4. **Moles Black Rat 6.0%**
A strong dry premium blend cider full of flavour with a clean apple bite. Produce traditionally in a family Somerset cider Farmhouse using a blend of locally grown apples.
