

Ideas

- Ask God for his heart of compassion for people
- Make a list of the friendship networks in your Cell – your ‘Cell Community’. Feedback any encouraging news or stories
- Pray for opportunities and for boldness
- Plan socials, e.g. pub quiz, meals together, parties
- Think creatively about ways to serve your friends
- Pray for evangelists in the Cell and get them to pray for the rest of the Cell
- Set targets for the weeks, e.g. number of God conversations, feedback the following week
- Light night lights for each person you are praying for which you can then take away and continue praying for them

Witness

(15 mins)

Purpose

To reach our friends who don't know God through the Cell group and so grow big enough to multiply.

How?

Effective witnessing should come out of the overflow of our life together in God.

The role of the Cell is to empower us to be witnesses and to reach our friends with the gospel. That's done through accountability to the group, to encourage prayer and an expectation that God is going to use us.

The group can create strategies together to reach those who are not-yet Christians, taking responsibility together for one another's friends, e.g. socials to invite people's friends to.
