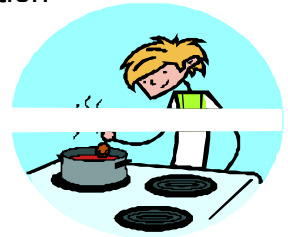
who is eligible ?

- you should be between the age of 16-25
- you should have either a diagnosed mental health condition or a concern about how your mental health or emotional state impacts on your ability to either maintain or identify suitable housing
- you should commit to meeting with a tenancy support worker on a weekly basis
- you should be from Kingswood or South Gloucestershire

about the program:

Once accepted to receive support, you will either be visited by or meet with a specialised tenancy support worker, who will provide:

- initial needs assessment and client-centred support plan
- if currently inappropriately housed, support in accessing housing providers as well as applying to the local authority housing department
- an opportunity to reflect on your current situation in a meaningful way
- practical advice and assistance on managing daily tasks in relation to your tenancy
- benefits and housing advice
- accessing local services
- dealing with neighbours and guests



how this is achieved :

Before the support begins, a personal action plan will be created, focusing on both immediate needs as well as medium term targets.

A support plan will then be completed, creating a contract between ourselves and you, the young person, agreeing details such as where to meet, frequency and type of support to be provided.

The program will be tailored around work or education commitments, so we will be flexible in our approach.
