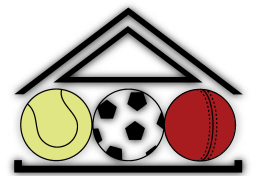

## New Pavilion Update

The Little Gaddesden Sports Club Committee, includes representatives of the Tennis, Football and Cricket clubs, has been working with the Parish Council on plans to upgrade the existing Pavilion.

I think we would all agree that this is much needed. If you still need convincing, just take a walk around the changing rooms and the single shower room! It's time we had a new Pavilion.

This is what the Sports Club together with the Parish Council have agreed to do, but there is a long way to go and much money to be raised if we are to succeed.

Firstly, as a member of either the Football, Tennis or Cricket clubs you are also a member of the Sports Club, whether you live in the village or not. As such, the existing Pavilion and the proposed new Pavilion is your Pavilion too.

The plans for the rebuilding of the Pavilion are well underway and initial drawings are available to be viewed in the Pavilion. The next step is to conclude the business plan and submit formal plans for planning permission. Once this is granted by Dacorum Council, in theory, work can begin.

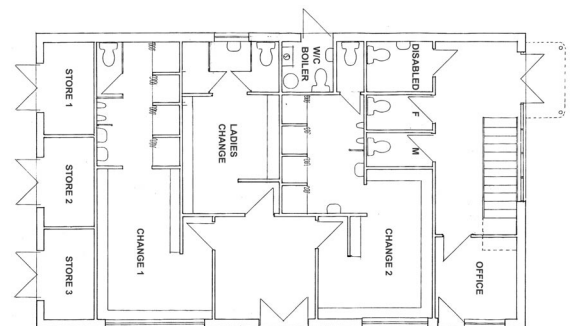
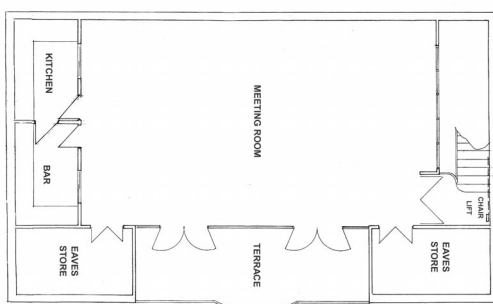
A key factor as to how soon building work will start and therefore finish, will be the speed at which we can raise the funds required.

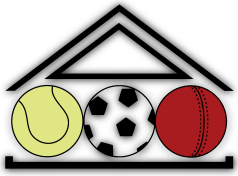
Proposals for funding are being put together for submission to the Lottery Commission and, Sport England and others but inevitably we will be required to raise a significant sum of money ourselves.

Although the exact costs are being worked on, it is estimated that the overall cost for the new building will be in the order of £300,000. It is expected that our contribution to the programme could be in the order of £100,000.

This sounds a lot but we can do it.....we will do it and work on raising these funds has already started. A calendar of initial fund-raising events over the next few months is detailed overleaf.

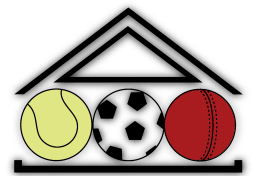

### CALENDAR OF EVENTS



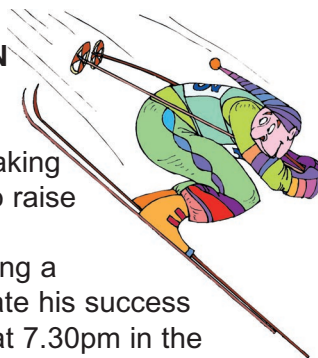

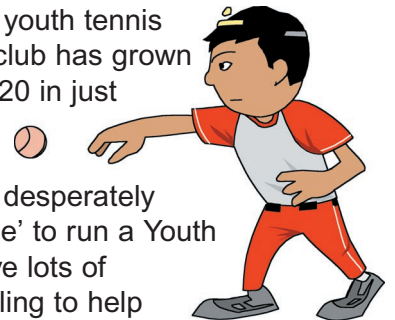
