### South Essex Insurance Brokers Cross Country 2008

The SEIB BHS Cross Country Championship Finals is open to current BHS Gold members who have qualified at one of the many qualifying events held around the country. Riders may only enter the particular class(es) they qualified for, and this must be on the qualified horse or pony.

In the nominated qualifying classes, the two highest placed riders or pairs who are BHS Gold Members on the day of the qualifier will qualify for the final. In the event of a combination of horse/pony and rider already having qualified, the qualification will pass down to the next eligible competitor.

You must provide the event secretary with your BHS membership number when you enter the qualifier but it is recommended that you also carry your membership card on the day. Non-BHS members may enter (and win) qualifying classes but will not be eligible to qualify for the final.

Horses registered for British Eventing Horse Trials in 2008 are not eligible to qualify for the finals although "BE Day Tickets" are acceptable.

Rules at qualifiers may differ from those at the finals. Classes at the finals will be Novice and Pairs (both max 2'9"), and Open (max 3'3). The finals will take place on 28 September 2008, at Eland Lodge Equestrian, Draycott-in-the-Clay, Sudbury, Derbyshire.
